

Protocols for Testing & Quarantine Covid-19

Unvaccinated

Vaccinated

Test Positive for Covid-19

- Isolate for minimum of 10 days
- Return when fever free & no other symptoms

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Asymptomatic Close Contact

- 3 Options
 - Test & Stay
 - Traditional Protocol
 - No Covid Test
- See Covid Handbook for details

- Exempt from testing & quarantining
- If symptoms occur, stay home & test

Symptomatic Individuals

- Take PCR Test
 - If negative, return
 - If positive, follow protocol for positive test
- If alternate diagnosis given by medical professional, no testing required

- Take PCR Test
 - If negative, return
 - If positive, follow protocol for positive test
- If alternate diagnosis given by medical professional, no testing required
- If not a close contact, should test only if experiencing symptoms in **bold**

Travel

- If you travel outside of MA, you must either:
 - Quarantine for 10 days
 - Produce a negative test taken no more than 72 hours prior to arrival

- If you travel outside of MA, you are exempt from quarantine or testing

Covid-19 Symptom List

- **Fever (100.0° Fahrenheit or higher), chills, or shaking chills**
- **Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath**
- **New loss of taste or smell**
- **Muscle aches or body aches**
- Cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
- Sore throat, when in combination with other symptoms
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea when in combination with other symptoms
- Headache when in combination with other symptoms
- Fatigue, when in combination with other symptoms
- Nasal congestion or runny nose (not due to other known causes, such as allergies) when in combination with other symptoms
